ExcellenSeas Scholarship Program

The Non-Profit Civil Company “**Thalasses Aristeias**” (**ExcellenSeas**), together with its swimming team **Pastra Cretonaxiosa**, successfully completed the annual swimming crossing, dedicated to the outstanding students and scholars from Greece’s remote island regions.

This year’s event, held under the auspices of H.E. the President of the Hellenic Republic Mr. Constantine An. Tassoulas, took place on Saturday, October 18, 2025, covering a distance of 23,430 meters from Kalamos to Lefkada.

The start was given by Mr. Antonios Karavias, a resident of Kalamos, in a symbolic gesture of support for the organization’s mission. During the crossing, the swimmers were accompanied by dolphins, offering a touching and unforgettable moment that highlighted the deep connection between humans and the sea.

The purpose of this symbolic initiative is to raise awareness and support the mission of “Seas of Excellence” (ExcellenSeas) through its scholarship program, which has been honored by the Academy of Athens and supports university students originating from Greece’s island communities.

This year’s swimming team consisted of: Eugenia Tzannini, Apostolos Tsagkarakis, Vasileios Maroulis, Sofia Psilolignou, and Vasileios Sofikitis.

About the "ExcellenSeas" Scholarship Program

ExcellenSeas was initiated by the Pastra Cretonaxiosa swim team after years of long-distance swims and close engagement with remote island communities. Experiencing first-hand the unique challenges faced by youth in these regions, the team turned its mission toward raising awareness and collecting funds to support university students from these islands.

Since its founding in 2018, the program has provided 49 multi-year scholarships to students from small and remote Greek islands, including Donousa, Astypalaia, Amorgos, Kastellorizo, Meganisi, Agios Efstratios, Kalymnos, Nisyros, Chalki, Psara, Kasos, Symi, Leipsoi, Oinousses, and Fournoi.

The initiative operates under the scientific supervision of a distinguished Academic Council composed of full and emeritus professors from Greek and international universities, along with prominent experts with high academic and ethical credentials. This Council selects recipients and follows their academic progress, while also providing mentorship toward their professional development.

ExcellenSeas scholarships cover up to €7,000 per year, supporting tuition and living expenses throughout the students' university studies. The program also facilitates internship opportunities aligned with each scholar's field of study.
